Timecard Compliance– All drivers need to be aware of their obligation to full complete their timecard every day they work. It's not just a Marley's requirement but a state government one and if you get pulled over and your records aren't up to scratch can be fined. From a audit perspective every time you fail to complete a single timeline, daily check or other part of your timecard or don't comply with fatigue guidelines it is recorded as a non-conformance. We are going to start cracking down on minor non-conformances to try and reduce the number of them. Drivers will soon be receiving a phone call each week an issue is identified. We understand some drivers struggle with paperwork but we all have to accept the fact that paperwork is part of the modern drivers job and it is essential that it is done correctly as you are legally accountable for it.

Bookings for holidays in December are now CLOSED. No more leave applications for December or Christmas to New Year period can be accepted.

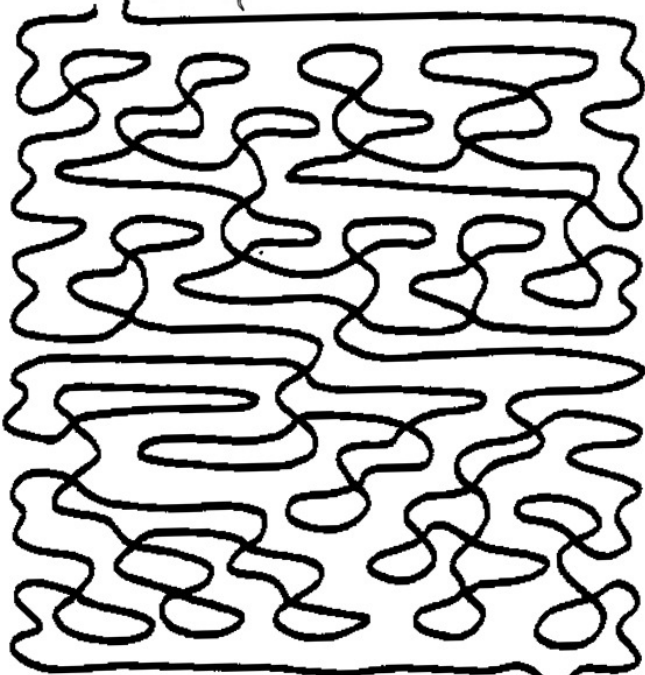
