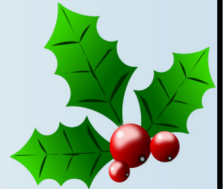

Marley's put another new rig on the road this month. This new auger trailer is the highest capacity ever built by Walinga with a payload of 64 tonnes. In most other aspects it is the same as our previous auger trailers with the 6 compartments in the rear trailer discharging through the floor, feeding into the back of the lead trailer, through the floor of the lead trailer and then up the main boom auger. It can all be operated by remote control with onboard ECM with soft start and pressure compensating hydraulics to ensure optimum discharge rates of around 1.5 - 2 tonnes per minute.

MT Data Tracking System

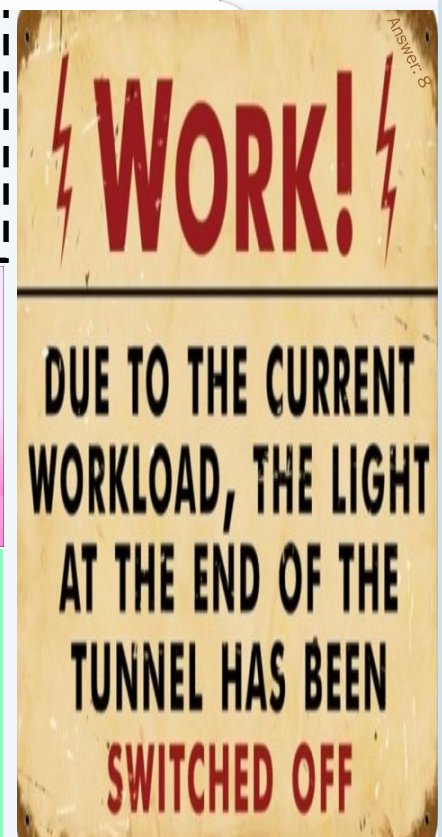
First thing Monday morning remember to check your tablet to ensure that the battery has not gone flat, the power button is on the top left hand corner of the tablet.

Please ensure that you login and logout for each shift.

I know we have had a rough time during the introduction with this system (as to be expected with new systems) and we are working very closely with MTD to try to fix fatigue break issues, phone issues and way-point speeding. We appreciate your patience during this time.
