3 Dolly's (DL 13,20 & 28)

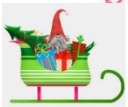

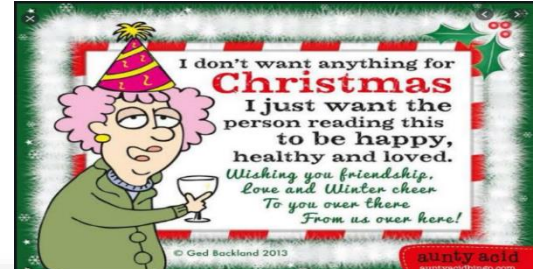
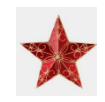
